Ananas Noir	Beautiful large beefsteak 1 to 1 1/2 lb fruit developed by Pascal Moreau, a horticulturist from Belgium. The multi-colored, smooth fruit. The flesh is bright green with deep red streaks. Superb flavor that is outstanding, being both sweet and smoky with a hint of citrus. Also know as Black Pineapple.	
Aunt Gerties Gold	1 lb fruit best tasting yellow. Heirloom from Virginia	
Aunt Ruby's German Green	Large green beefsteaks. Can grow to over 1 pound and is delicious. It has brilliant, neon-green flesh with a strong, sweet, and fruity flavor, much tastier than most red tomatoes. This family heirloom from Germany is beautiful.	
Black From Tula	Deep reddish brown medium size; sweet flavor; very productive even during hot weather	
Burantino	High yields, hardy and multipurpose. Balanced flavor and texture.

Edirne Purple Striped	A delectable edible ornamental, this pretty purple-striped eggplant is fit for a fairy-tale garden. It was collected in Edirne (Adrianople), Turkey, in 1948, and stored by the USDA ever since. The gorgeous 6-8 inch fruit is richly striped in purple and off-white. Vigorous plants are very productive.	
Fengyuan Purple	Asian purple, long fruit, great for grilling and stir fries	
Listada De Gandia	Italian heirloom. Considered one of the most beautiful of all eggplants. Rich purple striping. Mildwhite flesh.
